The rice was cultivated at Batakuchi by Aashaa Bora. Mr. Rana organised the Rongali Bihu there and in the same stage the rice was distributed to them. A blind school student sang a beautiful song as well. Mr. Bhubaneswar Kakati compered the programme. All the members of Aashaa Bora Foundation and Hitarth were felicitated by him on behalf of the Bihu organisers as a mark of acknowledgement of their service on the day.

Overall the programme went smoothly. Such an initiative of Aashaa Bora Foundation was really helpful for those who received the rice bags. The volunteers who helped in distribution of the rice were motivated by the recognition that they received for their services.
