FUTURE FOOD FOR THE NEEDY



A programme “**Food for the Needy**” was conducted by Aashaa Bora Foundation at Batakuchi, Digaru on 19th July 2015.

Aashaa Bora Foundation was established in 1991-1992 and registered under the Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1860. Aashaa Bora Foundation is a non-profitable, non-governmental and non-political entity based in Guwahati, Assam (India). Aashaa Bora Foundation was founded by a women entrepreneur and social worker Dr. Aashaa Bora, working in the areas of skill development, livelihood generation, health care, children’s rights and women’s empowerment. The aim of the foundation is to generate awareness among various communities through a system of dissemination, where in organizations and individuals are given access to information of new technological initiatives and production enterprise.

The motive of this programme is to help the needy people by giving them the rice that will be cultivated in the paddy field of Batakuchi.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PROGRAMME



In this programme Milon Rongpi, village headman of Batakuchi was invited. The cultivation of paddy crops in Batakuchi was inaugurated by Aashaa Bora, president of Aashaa Bora Foundation.

Twenty farmers including men and women were present to cultivate the paddy crops. 12 bighas of land was used for the cultivation of paddy crops. The team members of Aashaa Bora Foundation have also took part in cultivating the paddy crops. The media persons interviewed the president of Aashaa

Bora Foundation, Aashaa Bora including its team members and also to the farmers present in the programme. In this programme the team members of Aashaa Bora Foundation collected information about the family background, standard of living, income source & also the daily income of the farmers who cultivated the paddy crops. The programme was ended by providing lunch to the farmers who cultivated in the paddy crops by the president of Aashaa Bora Foundation.
