INTRODUCTION

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

On 25th October, 2015 a **Free Health Check Up** programme was organised by Aashaa Bora Foundation in Bongara, in association with GNRC. In this programme free health check up was provided to the village people.

The programme was started from 10 o'clock to till 2.30 pm. Total six medical practitioners from GNRC, Guwahati attended the programme. The main objective of this programme was to give free health check up to the poor people of Bongara because a healthy person is an asset to himself, to his family and to his community. Health is real wealth. Poor financial conditions of the people don't allow them visit a doctor when they are unwell. Thus taking this situation in concern we Aashaa Bora Foundation, on 25th October 2015 organised a free health check up camp at Bongara for the needy people in collaboration with GNRC.

During the programme more than two hundred people came for health check up. Besides giving the free health check up ECG and Ultrasound tests were also done for free. In the end of the programme Aashaa Bora, the president of Aashaa Bora Foundation delivered some valuable speech to the village people regarding health care. The people of Bongara were very satisfied and benefitted by the programme.

Aashaa Bora Foundation took an initiative to organise health check up camp among the village people in Bongara in association with GNRC.
